How to come to Munich?

by Flight:

Munich's International Airport is about 40 km far from the City.

The Taxi to the hotel costs about 60 €.

To take the S-Bahn (regional train) is highly recommended (about 45 min to Marienplatz). It costs about 9 €. You have to buy a blue ticket (called Streifenkarte, 10.5 €) which can be used for 10 short trips. In order to come to the hotel you must cancel 8 of them.

There are two S-Bahn lines! Take line number **8** to the station Marienplatz. The Hotel Mercure is within walking distance to Marienplatz (for further information and address see http://www.mercure.com/mercure/fichehotel/de/mer/3709/fiche_hotel.shtml).

by Train:

If you arrive by train at the Central Station (Hauptbahnhof) you can take every S-Bahn (regional train) which goes to the City Centre, Marienplatz (S1-S8, about 5 min).

For the trip you can buy a single ticket, 2.20 € or you can use the above mentioned blue ticket. You have to cancel 2 strips. Leave the train at the Station Marienplatz. The Hotel Mercure is within walking distance to Marienplatz (for further information and address see http://www.mercure.com/mercure/fichehotel/de/mer/3709/fiche_hotel.shtml).
