## How to come to Linz?

### by Plane: Getting from to the airport:

- **Shuttle Service**

Passengers arriving in Linz are invited to use the free shuttle service between Linz Airport and Hörsching station from 5.00 a.m. to 10 p.m., available on request. This transfer takes about three minutes.

To order a shuttle service, please contact the information desk at the airport or the station manager at Hörsching station

- **Blue Danube Airport Lines**

The bus is a comfortable and quick way to get to the airport:

**by Train:** Hourly Intercity and Eurocity connections to Salzburg and Vienna. If you arrive at the Linz Central Station (Hauptbahnhof) by train you can reach the Hotel IBIS on foot in 1 minute. In front of the station you cross the Kärntnerstraße at the traffic light and you are in front of the Hotel IBIS

**by Car:** Motorway (A1) from Munich – Salzburg - Vienna – Budapest,  
Motorway (A8) from Passau – Regensburg,  
Motorway (A7) from Prague

**by Ship:** Linz is situated on one of Europe's most important waterways, the Danube, which is linked to the Rhine and the Main. Linz is a popular stopover for cycle tourists on the Danube bicycle path from Passau to Vienna.
